
# Humanism is man's attempt to <u>solve his</u> <u>problems</u> independently of <u>God</u>

- Study







- 4. Discipline produces godliness.


Rules and regulations are not designed just to keep you in but are also to keep dangers out.



## Three Main Categories of Influential Relationships in Your Life



- 3. With others



• We are called to go into the world to minister to people's needs.

## Wrong friends build wrong patterns for our lives.

- Do not go with them (Prov. 1:15).
- Do not <u>yield</u> to their <u>ways</u> (Prov. 25:26).
  - By <u>overlooking</u> their sin (Prov. 28:23)
  - By honoring them (Prov. 26:1)
- Do not become their friend (Prov. 22:24).
- Do not become a <u>companion</u> to them in their sin (Prov. 29:24).

#### **How A Wrong Companion Acts**

- His Mouth
  - Curses (Exo. 20:7)
  - Uses crude words
  - <u>Uses immoral words</u> (Eph. 5:4)
  - <u>Gossips</u> (Eph. 4:29)
  - Criticizes
  - <u>Tells lies</u> (Prov. 6:16-19)
- His Eyes
  - Lustful looks (1 John 2:16)
  - <u>Jealousy</u> (1 Sam. 18:7-9)
  - Fault-finding (Matt. 7:3-5)
  - Rebelliousness (Prov. 30:17)
- His Feet: go places they should not go (Prov. 6:18)

#### **Friendliness**

- Definition: showing an interest in the life and affairs of others.
- Antonyms
  - Selfishness
  - Self-centeredness
- Characteristics
  - A friendly person...
    - Listens as much as he talks
    - Asks questions and shows an interest in what others are talking about

#### **Friendliness (Continued)**

- Smiles
  - To show he is interested in others and not self-conscious
  - To show he is kind and not cold and uncaring
  - To put others at ease by showing he is not tense or nervous

## The basis of <u>love</u> is the character of <u>Jesus</u> (John <u>3:16</u>; <u>15:13</u>; Rom. <u>5:8</u>; 1 John <u>4:9-10</u>).

#### God's love...

- Extends to all mankind
- Does not depend on our loving Him
- Was expressed for us on the cross

## Genuine love is meeting the needs of others.

#### Showing genuine love means we will...

- Love <u>all people</u>, not just our <u>best friends</u>.
- Love those who despise and hurt us.
- Show our love to others, not just talk about it.

- Self-control (or temperance)


#### Character

- Original Meaning: an engraving instrument
- Definition: Living and acting by a <u>predetermined</u> set of <u>life</u> <u>principles</u> that <u>engrave</u> right patterns of behavior into my life.

## **Building Christian Character**

- Carpenters:
  - Parents
  - Friends
  - Environment
  - Self-effort (personal choices)
  - Holy Spirit
- The Structure:

Bible <u>principles</u>: <u>rules</u> or <u>laws</u> based on the <u>character</u> of God which never <u>change</u> and by which we govern our lives

#### Meekness

- Definition
   An inward attitude that <u>yields</u> all <u>rights</u> and <u>expectations</u> to <u>God</u>
- Antonyms
  - Arrogance
  - Pride
- Synonyms
  - **Humility**
  - Submission

#### When we are meek, we do not...

- Argue and demand our rights
- Push to be first
- Seek to get even
- Rebel against authority
- Boast of our accomplishments
- Worry about rewards for everything we do

#### **Self-Control**

Definition
 The <u>discipline</u> of the whole life: <u>body</u> and <u>spirit</u>.

- Antonyms
  - Chaos
  - Defenseless
- Synonyms
  - Spirit-control
  - Mature stability
- Principle
  - We need the <u>power</u> of the Holy Spirit to lead a <u>disciplined</u> life.
- Proverb: One who has no <u>control over his own spirit</u> is like a city with <u>broken down laws</u> (25:28).

#### **Courage and Temptation**

- The Command: Be strong and courageous (Josh. 1:9).
- The Danger: We wrestle against the <u>spiritual powers of wicked-ness and darkness</u> (Eph. 6:12).
- God's Provision: <u>Power</u>, <u>love</u>, and a <u>disciplined mind</u> (2 Tim. 1:7)
- Our Attitude: Be <u>serious-minded</u> and <u>alert</u> (1 Pet. 5:8).
- The Result: The <u>devil</u> will <u>flee</u> from us (James 4:7).

## Why should we desire to know God's will?

- God made us for a purpose.
- Finding God's will is finding God's purpose for me.

### Doing God's will means...

- Obeying the clear commands in Scripture
- Doing what we were <u>designed</u> to do
- Pleasing God

## Why We Don't Do God's Will

- Satan blinds us...
  - By making us think God's will makes us <u>miserable</u>
  - By making us judge by our <u>feelings</u> and by <u>outward</u> <u>appearance</u>
- Believers are not in a position to know God's will when...
  - Sin in our lives keeps us from seeking God's wisdom
  - Failing to <u>listen</u> keeps us from <u>hearing</u>

## **Develop a Thankful Attitude**

- Thankfulness overcomes...
  - Envy
  - Greed
  - Jealousy
  - Covetousness
- Thankfulness <u>lifts</u> us up. <u>Greed</u> and <u>covetousness</u>
   pull us down and keep us <u>discontent</u> and <u>unhappy</u>.
- Giving thanks in everything is the will of God (1 Thess. 5:18).

#### Money Is a Gift from God

- Blessings
  - A benefit for the wise (Prov. 14:24)
  - Many <u>friendships</u> (14:20; 19:4)
  - <u>Security</u> (10:15)
- Our Responsibility
  - Be <u>diligent</u> (10:4)
  - Take good care of things (27:23-25)
  - Remember... (27:23-27)
    - Things do not <u>last forever</u>.
    - Everything has a <u>use</u> for our <u>good</u>.
    - God promises to provide <u>all our needs</u>.

#### **Proverbs 15:16-17**

It is better to have <u>little</u> and <u>fear</u> the Lord than to have great <u>treasure</u> with great <u>troubles</u>

## **Our Thoughts Affect Our...**

- <u>Health</u> (Prov. 14:30)
- <u>Faces</u> (15:13)
- Speech (15:28; 16:23)
- Attitudes toward sin (16:6)

#### **Our Tongues Reveal Our Character**

- The tongue needs to be controlled (James 3:2-4).
  - A <u>bridle</u> is needed for an <u>untamed youth</u> who is not ready to run his own life.
  - A <u>helm</u> is needed for <u>adults</u> to speak in the right spirit.
- Uncontrolled, it has power to harm (James 3:5-8).
  - It is a raging <u>fire</u> that can <u>defile</u> yourself and others.
  - It is a deadly <u>poison</u> that can destroy <u>friendships</u>.
- Controlled, it has power to bless (James 3:9-12).

#### **What We Say Affects Others**

- Don't <u>say</u> what you are <u>thinking</u> until you are sure that it will <u>edify</u> the other person.
- Always consider...
  - What to say
  - How to say it
  - When to say it
- Why we should not always say what we think
   Wise men...
  - Think before they speak
  - Get the <u>facts</u> before they <u>speak</u>
  - Consider the consequences before they speak
  - Speak only the things that <u>edify</u> (build others up)

#### **Peace**

- Principle: Success is having peace in <u>all</u> <u>circumstances of life</u>.
- Definition: Peace is <u>realizing God has</u> <u>provided all I need</u>.
- Three Kinds
  - 1. Peace with God (upward)
  - 2. Peace of God (inward)
  - 3. Peace with men (outward)
- Antonyms
  - Anxiety
  - Worry
- Synonym: contentment

Setting goals and working hard

- Forget the <u>past</u>.
- Look forward to the <u>new things</u>
   God has planned for you.
- Press <u>forward</u> to the <u>purpose</u> God has called you to accomplish.
